We will be doing lots of Christmas crafts and reading lots of Christmas books.


Our letters for the month will be J & S

We are already practicing our songs that we will be singing at our Christmas program which will take place on Friday December 19th, we hope you can join us!




Happy Winters,

We have three birthdays on December!! We also have Christmas concert on Dec 19. We are looking forward to showing children's songs at concert.








This November, our class finished exploring "Ball". They learned how to ask questions to investigate an object, and learned about the use, material, size, weights, colors, and so many other aspects to define an object like a ball. They learned how to compare by using the words longer/ shorter, bigger/smaller, heavier/lighter. They are learning the rhyming words and the opposite words as well. In math, we have discussed measurements, counting, and tally marks. We have already completed the book "Ball Study" and started to learn about trees. In "Tree study", we have started with learning where we see the trees, what the different parts of trees are, and different types of trees as they differ by different types of leaves, heights, and bark etc.

Since the kids in our class are encouraged to use their fine motor skills, they are practicing using scissors, writing, and coloring with crayons, playing with Play-Doh, and doing other crafts with papers, beads, and strings. Every day, the kids are encouraged to practice some exercises to stretch, run, and perform movements following instructions to strengthen their gross motor skills.
