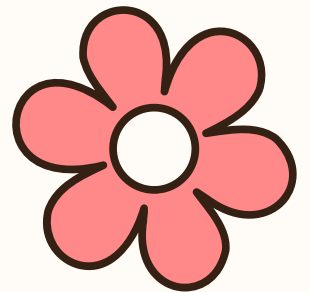


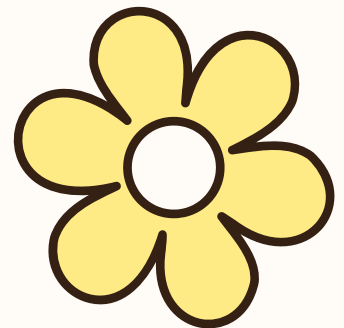
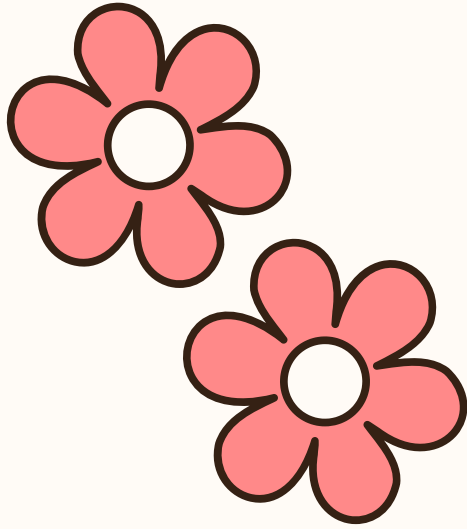
The end of another school year is just around the corner and it's time to reflect on thankfulness for the time I've had with your children. I have observed change not only in growth and development but also in their social skills.

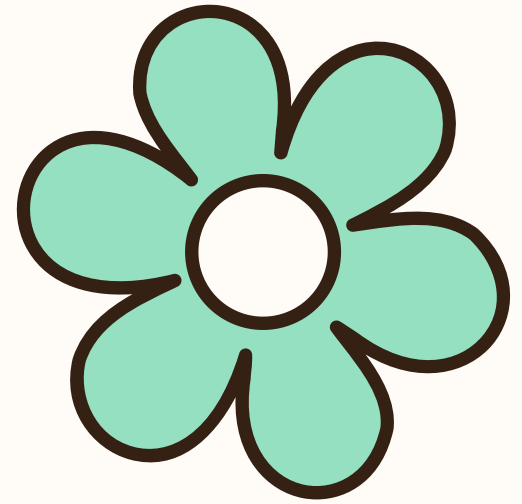

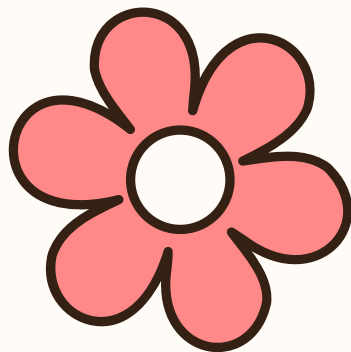
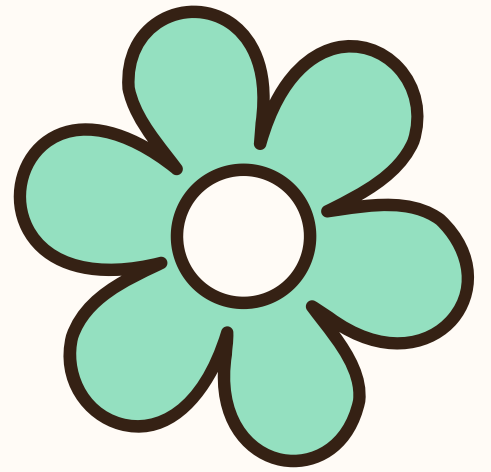
As we move into May, our hearts are filled with both happiness and a little sadness. It is hard to believe that the school year is coming to an end.

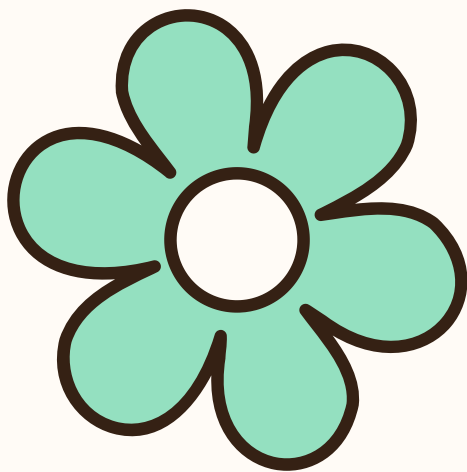
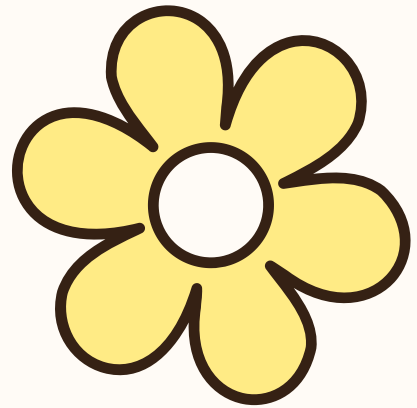
